- Google Classroom (GCR) facilities are also available to post the information and reposit the class notes and links for the references. Moodle online portal access is available for all the students with a unique ID.
- Blended learning is implemented through these google applications everyday.
- Library has an automated KOHA software system for library organization. Delnet, an online journal application, is open to all students and faculties. It can be accessed remotely too. Students can access e PG pathshala, MOOC courses at the computer facilities in the lab with high speed internet access.
- GEAR box application is created to post the innovative ideas to contribute for Innovation and development of entrepreneurship.
- For the e-governance system, MEDSTEER- an HMS software is installed to communicate with the IT department, Electrical department, Plumbing department and maintenance department.
- Edumate software is available for student governance. Basic demographic details and academic details are stored in Edumate.
- Alumni book application is installed for the Alumni registration which has provision
 to enter all the work details, achievement and progress. A link is shared in the Alumni
 whatsapp group to get registered to Alumni book. These details can be accessed by all
 the students of our institute to widen the placement opportunities.

CONTENT:

Our college has extensive collaborative activities with the NGOs through establishment of Memorandum of Understanding (MoUs).

- **Jally home** a home for underprivileged children from the **gypsy** community. The institution is providing free education to nomatic girl child in B.Sc.Nursing course every year with the aim to promote the underprivileged society through education.
- Satya Special School, a school for specially challenged children. MoU is signed with this organization for the nursing care service, health awareness program and research relevant to specially challenged. Awareness on dietary influence for Cerebral palsy was organized at 4 centers of Satya Special School for the Antenatal mother. Research was conducted among the mothers with specially challenged children about the child safety practices. Our students actively participated in Rally to create awareness about the rights of Specially challenged children for the public.
- In collaboration with **Rotaract association**, a NGO for voluntary services, a blood donation campaign was organized and collected 100 units of blood for the JIPMER blood bank with our student and faculty volunteers.
- **Uyirthuli** is a voluntary organization for social service. Had a good contribution towards the organization of health awareness sessions on Dengue, organ donation and Blood donation at schools and colleges around Puducherry.
